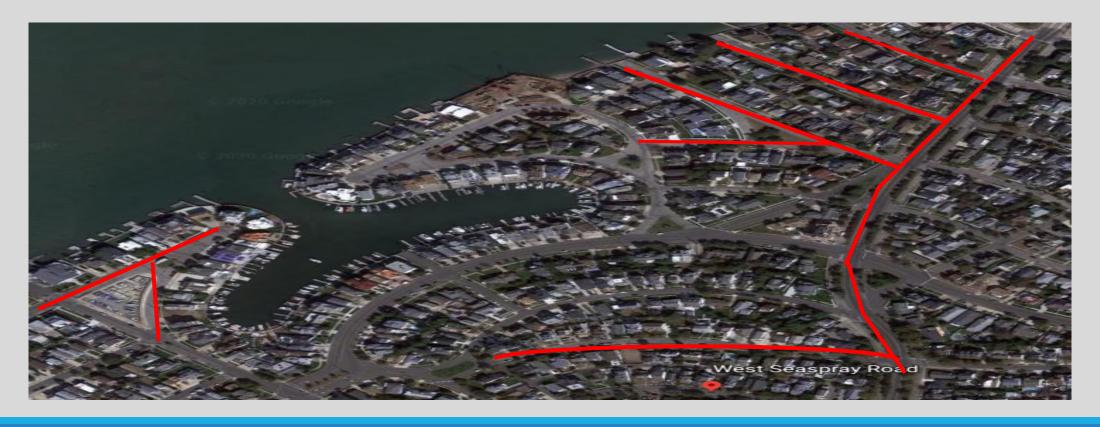

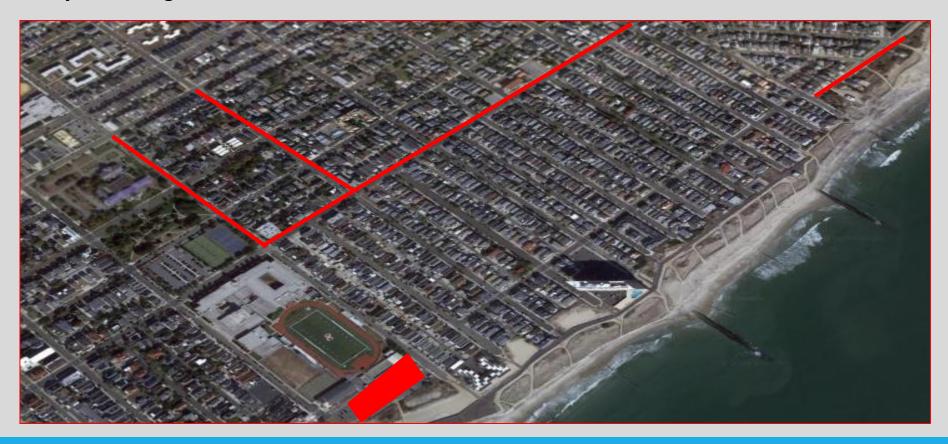

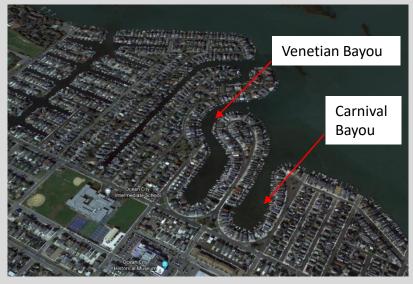

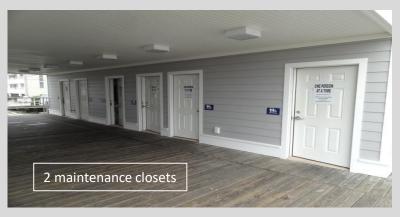

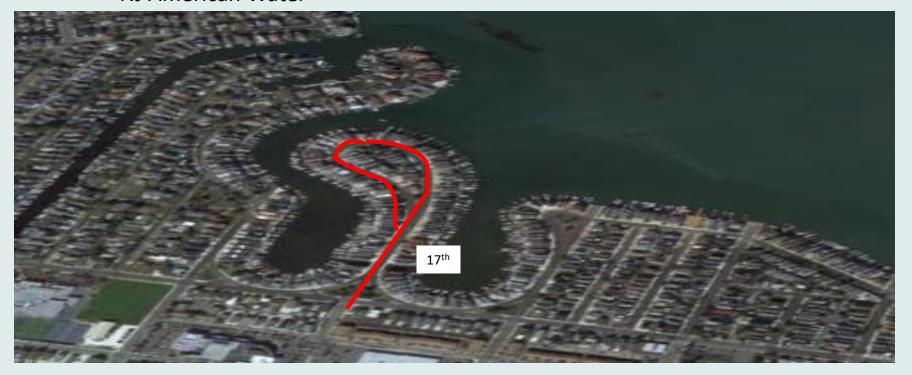

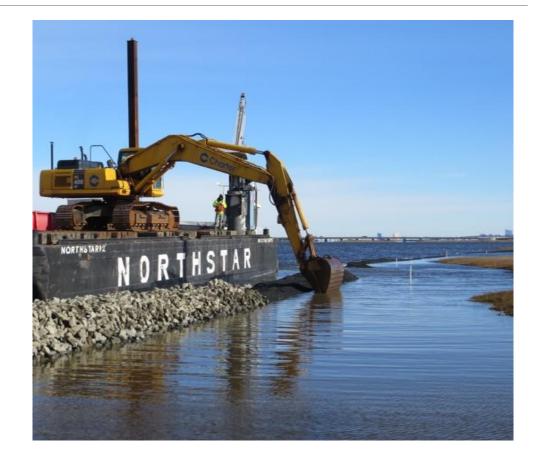

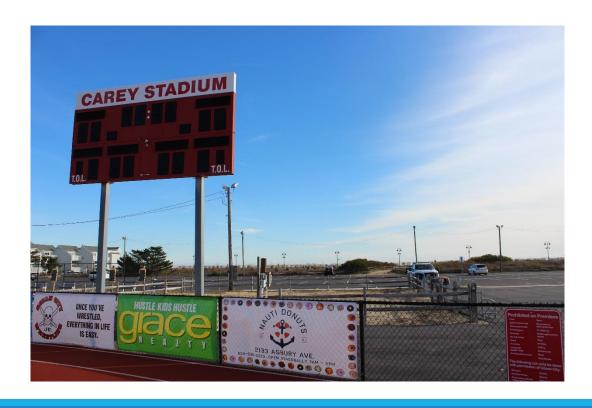

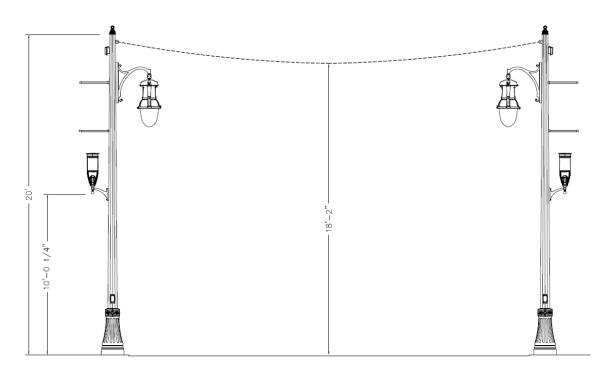

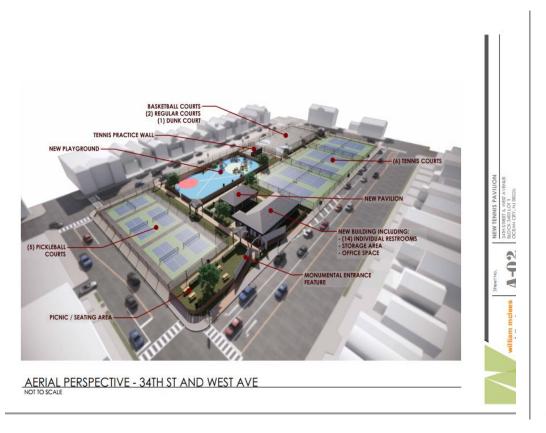

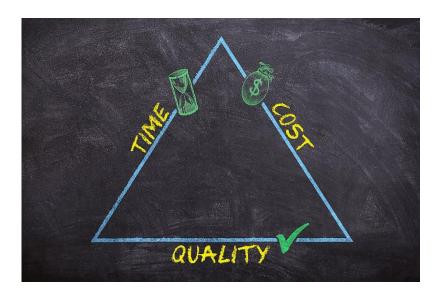

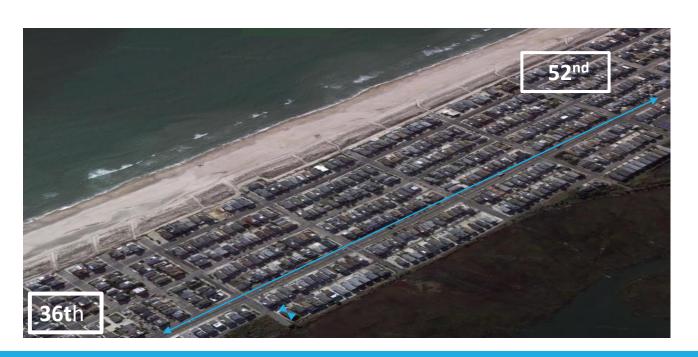

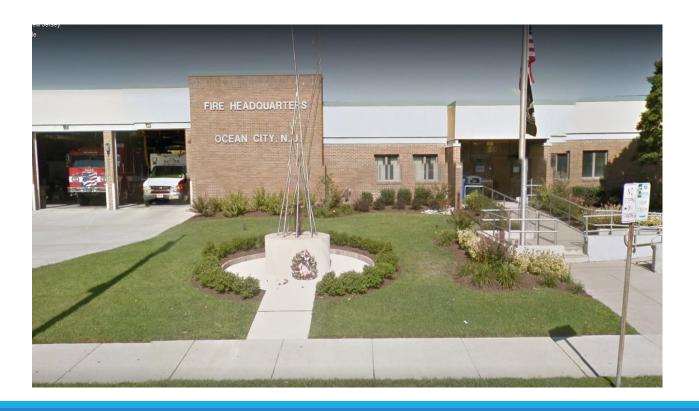

□ Capital Improvement Fund (CIF)

- ☐ Must provide 5% down payment on capital improvements through each bond ordinance (some exceptions)
- □CIF is included in the operating budget each year
- ☐ This 5 year plan at \$146 mil represents \$138 mil of debt going forward not counting any offsets for grants



\$138 mil in debt service for 2023-2027 previously mentioned

- again assuming no grant offsets from any of the multiple sources potentially available

\$35 mil in unfunded debt on our books as of 12/31/22 from projects funded in 2021 and 2022

The debt service model on the next two slides demonstrates the capacity to bond over \$180 mil over the next 7 years with bond sales planned for 2024, 2026 and 2028



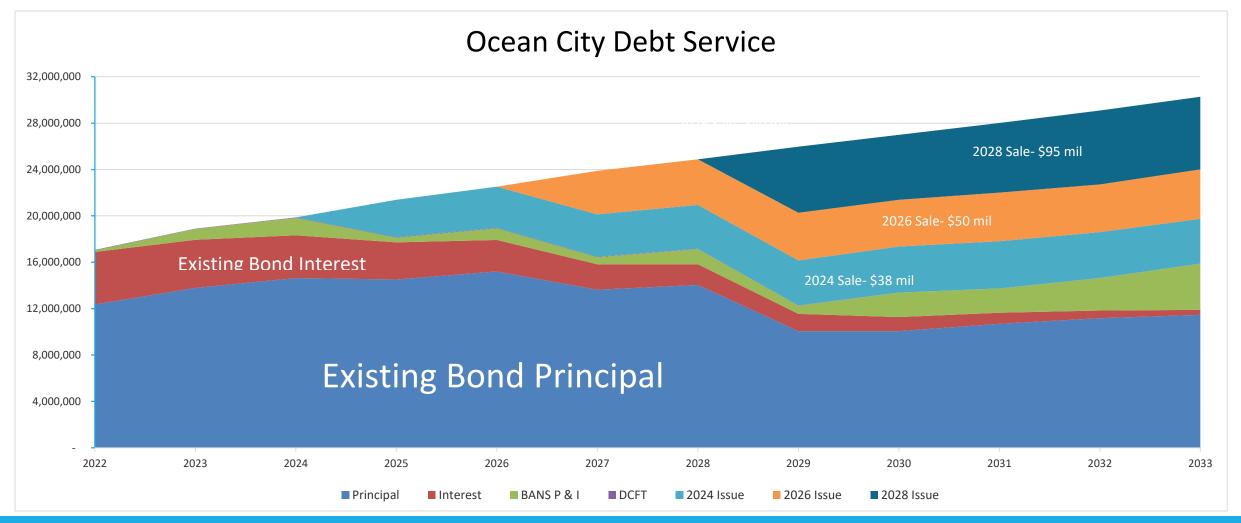
