

## 1. Merion Park II Contract

- Ocean City's Areas are shown in Green
- Cape May County's Areas shown as brown and blue

## 2. Schedule

- Submission of the Environmental Permits by June 2023
- Bid the project in the summer of 2023
- Construction Commencing in the late fall of 2023 once permits are approved

## 3. Ocean City's Scope of Work

- Raising the roadway grades between 3<sup>rd</sup> to the highest elevation possible; with the goal to minimize impacts to the residents' properties.
- Adding/replacing inlets where required, replacing piping, adding concrete gutters; replacing curbs and sidewalks that are impacted.
- Adding 3 new pump stations; expanding Pump Station #1 (MP I @ Four Seasons) to accommodate improvements around the Four Seasons, which would include creating a berm area to limit the tidal flooding from the marshes.
- Similar areas on Haven and 36<sup>th</sup> and the alley way between 36<sup>th</sup> & 37<sup>th</sup> would also get a berm to limit the frequent tidal flooding.

## 4. Cape May County's Scope of Work

- Reconstructing 34<sup>th</sup> Street and raising the grade of the roadway with the outbound lane being raised to Elevation 6.0.
- Replacing the median island between Little Roosevelt and 34<sup>th</sup> Street due to the raised roadway
- Adjusting the grades of Little Roosevelt to meet the raised median island
- Raising the roadway grades around the Acme and the intersections of West Avenue and 34<sup>th</sup>; 35<sup>th</sup>; 36<sup>th</sup> & 37<sup>th</sup>.
